Auntie Flo was a part of the Stolen Generation, separated from her family and sent to boarding school in Charters Towers under duress. Auntie Flo grew up in the Yarrabah Aboriginal Community which was established under the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Protection Act 1897.

In 1973 Auntie Flo commenced work in the Australian Public Service and worked throughout Australia in a number of different roles before going out on her own to start her consultancy business. During this time, she became a member of Reconciliation Qld Inc. appointed to various Boards and is active across many community organisations.

Auntie Flo is also an Elder with the Lord Mayor's group, was appointed by the Qld Premier as the first Patron of the Aboriginal Centre for the Performing Arts, has set up Elders groups throughout Qld to be viable businesses (in particular the Yarrabah Elders Group Inc.), received an OAM- Order of Australia medal, and continues to work in communities across Queensland with many government and non-government organisations to bring change and improvement of the lives of many Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples.

Auntie Flo to many, is an Elder, traditional owner and proud descendant of the Ghunghanghi People of Yarrabah, North Queensland. She also has a traditional affiliation with both the Kuku-yelangi people of Laura/Maytown, Palmer River area west of Cooktown and the Gurambilbarra Wulgurukaba people of Magnetic Island and Townsville.
