Katherine Collins was born in Meanjin (Brisbane), the youngest of seven children. On her mother's side, she comes from Yawaalaraay / Kooma - Dirranbandi, Queensland. Her father's Side is Githabul New South Wales (near Kyogle).

Katherine's work on her ancestry has helped her to address the grief from the passing of her parents.

This journey helped her to join **Inala Wangarra's Music Project "Singing Our Songlines"** -- a project of First Nations People, resulting in a CD and gigs at Events in Southeast Queensland. In a book "In Our Hands" Katherine published eight poems, some about her ancestry Journey, with poetry readings at

Katherine took part in an Inala Wangarra Project called "Shadow Sisters" inspired by Cherbourg's "Strong Women's Shadow Boxes" -- a love letter to ancestors whose history contributed to our lives. She has since participated in **First Nations Saltwater Embers Gold Coast Artist Camp on South Stradbroke Island**. Her poetry: "Lifecycle and Stages of Fire."
