As an articulated law clerk and student, **Paul Richard's** relationships with the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities developed, leading to his career in the Brisbane Tribal Council. By 1972, A.L.S. (Aboriginal Legal Services) had formed, beginning Paul's life-long career within ALS from 1973 – 1990, then working privately until retiring in 2015.

1973 – 1975 Brisbane A.L.S.

1976 – 1978 A.L.S. Cairns and N.Q.

1978 – 1979 worked on FAIRA book "Beyond the Act" and Indigenous entertainers workshop. Casework for A.L.S. South Burnett and Wide Bay.

1979 – 1981 Murgon office servicing Cherbourg region.

1982 – 1990 A.L.S. Brisbane.

1991 – 2000 Private practice, with indigenous community as significant client base.

2000 – 2008 Private bar.

2008 – 2015 Queensland South Native Title Services.

2015 Retired.
