Uncle David Wragge is a Wakka Wakka man from Cherbourg, Queensland, with traditional connections to Central Queensland (Ghungalu), and North Queensland (Juru, Bindal and Wulgurukba).

His mission is to foster a deeper understanding of historical events, colonisation, and government policies, helping to build more culturally informed and respectful relationships among Queensland Public Servants.

He is an advocate for the protection of children, particularly Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children – convinced that our children must be protected and taught about their respective cultural connections to the land and our traditional lore.

He supports Stolen Generations members across Australia to address ongoing (and intergenerational) trauma caused by the forcible removal of families and children from their traditional lands, culture, and communities, promoting their healing recovery.

Uncle David currently contributes his expertise to the Queensland Department of Women, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Partnerships, and Multiculturalism.
