brother Mack. Once at Cherbourg, Uncle Val was
separated from his siblings and grew up in a cruel
world without kindness or respect. A lost child
with no sense of Belonging.

Today, Uncle Val is a strong proud Aboriginal
man who supports his Aboriginal community in
health, housing, welfare, and funerals. Uncle Val
is also a Justice of the Peace.
