'My Reconciliation Journey' ***From the Back of Burke to the City***



AUNTY HEATHER CASTLEDINE, Aboriginal Co-Chair of the Brisbane Metropolitan Reconciliation Committee, shares her life story, from growing up in a country town segregated by race, working on stations in outback Queensland, to her professional career as a Social Worker in Child and Youth Mental Health and respected Aboriginal Elder within the Logan community.

AUNTY HEATHER CASTLEDINE is a proud Murri (Aboriginal) Elder.

As a young person, she worked in the outback for 27 years on cattle & sheep stations, shearing sheds and earth moving camps at the back of Bourke.

More recently, Aunty Heather has worked for Queensland Health with the Child and Youth Mental Health Service as an Indigenous Cultural Consultant to a Team of 35 clinicians.

Aunty Heather has a Bachelor of Social Work, Certificate IV in Indigenous Leadership, and Completed Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander Cultural Awareness Facilitator Training.

She received Outstanding Achievement for Reconciliation Learning Circle Kit, and Certificate of Participation in Applied Suicide Intervention Skills. She attends a Women's Workshop on grief & loss. She is former Co-Chair of the Reconciliation Queensland Inc Management Committee.
